Christmas Tree



MATERIALS

Main Color: Super Chunky wool (Bernat Softee Chunky in Med. Sea Green)

Hook Size: 3.5mm (E/4) crochet hook.

Fiberfill for stuffing

Size: 5" tall and 2.5" wide at base.

Gauge: Does not matter as bigger wool and bigger gauge will make larger tree.

Sequins, bead, or Pearl ended stick pins for decorations.

NOTES:

Do not join rounds unless otherwise indicated.

Use a yarn marker or contrasting yarn to mark rows.

Keep crochet stitches close together so the stuffing will not show when finished.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

st = stitch(es)

sl st = slip stitch

c2tog = crochet 2 st together

mc = main color

cc = contrasting color

MC = Magic Circle

BODY

1. Make a Magic Circle of 3 or (Ch 2 and in second from hook 3sc) (3)
2. 2 sc in st. (6)
3. 2 sc in st. (12)
4. * 1 sc in st, 3 sc in st * repeat around (24)
5. * 1 sc in st, skip 4 * repeat around (6)
6. 2 sc in st. (12)
7. 2 sc in st. (24)
8. * 1 sc in st, 3 sc in st * repeat around (48)
9. * 1 sc in st, skip 4 * repeat around (6)
10. 2 sc in st. (12)
11. 2 sc in st. (24)
12. 1 sc in st (24)
13. * 1 sc in st, 3 sc in st * repeat around (48)
14. * 1 sc in st, skip 6 * repeat around (6)
15. 2 sc in st. (12)
16. 2 sc in st. (24)
17. 2 sc in st (48)
18. * 1 sc in st, 3 sc in st * repeat around (96)
19. * 1 sc in st, skip 8 * repeat around (12)
20. 2 sc in st. (24)
21. 2 sc in st. (48)
22. 2 sc in st (96)
23. 1 sc in st (96)
23. * 1 sc in st, 3 sc in st * repeat around (192)
24. * 1 sc in st, skip 12 * repeat around (16)
25. 1 sl st in next st, cast off with long tail.

DECORATIONS

Sew or glue sequins or beads on tree for decorations.

Alternatively, push colored pearl ended stick pins into the tree at the bottom of the branch ends. Cut the stick pin in half with wire cutters for the top row.

For Star at the top, glue or double-sided tape the two star shaped sequins and put a pin in the middle or glue in place at the top of the tree.
