Halloween Pumpkin



This Free pattern will allow you to create a Halloween Pumpkin to compliment your decorations. Make several with different faces and put them everywhere.

Give them as Party Favors at your Halloween Party. This festive treat is low in calories for those who are watching their figures.

MATERIALS

Main Color: Worsted Wool (Paton's Satin in Sunset)

Contrasting Color: Worsted Wool (Paton's Astra in Black)

Needle: Yarn needle for sewing and embroidery.

Hook Size: 2.5mm (C/2)crochet hook.

Fiberfill for stuffing

Size: 2" tall and 3" diameter.

Gauge: Does not matter as bigger wool and bigger gauge will make larger pumpkin.

NOTES:

Do not join rounds unless otherwise indicated.

Use a yarn marker or contrasting yarn to mark rows.

Embroider eyes.

Keep crochet stitches close together so the stuffing will not show when finished.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

st = stitch(es)

sl st = slip stitch

c2tog = crochet 2 st together

mc = main color

cc = contrasting color

MC = Magic Circle

BODY

1. Make a Magic Circle of 8 or (Ch 2 and in second from hook 8 sc) (8)
2. 2 sc in each st. (16)
3. * 1 sc in st, 2 sc in next st* repeat around. (24)
4. * 1 sc in 2 st, 1 hdc in 2 st, 1 sc in 2 st, 1 sl st* repeat around (42)
- 5-11. * 1 sc in 3 st, 1 hdc in 2 st, 1 sc in 2 st* repeat around (42)
12. *c2tog, 1 sc in st, 1 hdc in 2 st, 1 sc in 2 st* repeat around (35)
13. * 1 sc in 2 st, 1 hdc in 2 st, 1 sc in 2 st* repeat around. (35)
14. * c2tog, 1 sc in st, 1 hdc in 2 st, 1 sc in st* repeat around (28)
15. * c2tog, 1 hdc in 2 st, 1 sc in st* repeat around (21)
16. * c2tog, 1 hdc in 2 st* repeat around (14)
17. *1 sc in st, 1 hdc in 2 st* repeat around (14) sl st in next st, cast off with long tail for sewing pieces together.

FACIAL FEATURES

With black wool, embroider small triangle for each eye and an upside down triangle for the nose and whatever kind of mouth you want. Make several in different configurations.
