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Rubber Duckie



This is a Pixie Kitten Free Pattern for this adorable Rubber Duckie. This adorable bathtub playmate is reproduced in detailed crochet. It stands four and a half inches long by three inches wide by three and a half inches tall.

This classic bath time buddy brings back many fond memories. And if you take it in the bath, probably won't float, but will bring back fond memories of a simpler time.

MATERIALS

Main Color: Super Chunky Wool (Bernat Melody in Sunny Yellow)

Contrasting Color: Worsted Wool (Bernat Stain in Sunset)

Eyes: Half round eyes (Glue on) (If giving to children: Embroider eyes)

Needle: Yarn needle for sewing and embroidery.

Hook Size: 3.5mm (E/4) crochet hook.

Fiberfill for stuffing

Size: 3.5" tall and 4.5" from beak to tail.

Gauge: Does not matter as bigger wool and bigger gauge will make larger rubber duckie and small wool and small gauge will make a baby rubber duckie.

NOTES:

Do not join rounds unless otherwise indicated.

Use a yarn marker or contrasting yarn to mark rows.

Glue eyes on or embroider eyes after brushing; I suggest waiting until the assembly is completed.

Keep crochet stitches close together so the stuffing won't show.

The number in brackets (#) at the end of the row is the number of stitches you should have in that row.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

st = stitch(es)

sl st = slip stitch

c2tog = crochet 2 st together

mc = main color

cc = contrasting color

MC = Magic Circle

BODY

1. In mc, Make a Magic Circle of 6 or (ch 2 and in 2nd ch from hook 6 sc) (6)
2. 2 sc in each st. (12)
3. * 1 sc in st, 2 sc in next st* repeat around. (18)
4. * 1 sc in 2 st, 2 sc in st* repeat around (24)
5. 1 sc in 4 st, * 2 hdc in 1 st, 1 dc in 4 st, 2 hdc in 1 st* 1 sc in 6 sc, then repeat from * to *, 1 sc in 2 st. (28)
6. 1 sc in 18 st, 1 hdc in 2 st, 1 dc in 4 st, 1 hdc in 2 st, 1 sc in 2 st (28)
7. 1 sc in 18 st, 1 hdc in 3 st, 1 dc in 2 st, 1 hdc in 3 st, 1 sc in 2 st (28)
8. 1 sc in 20 st, skip 1 st, 1 hdc in st, skip 2 st, 1 hdc in st, skip 1 st, 1 sc in 2 st (24)
9. 1 sc in 6 st, c2tog, 1 sc in st, c2tog, 1 sc in 6 st, 1 hdc in st, c2tog (3 times) (19)
10. 1 hdc in st, 1 sc in 4 st, 1 hdc in 6 st, 1 sc in 4 st, 1 hdc in st, c2tog, 1 hdc in st (18)
11. *1 sc in st, c2tog * repeat around (12)
12. 1 sc in each st (12)
13. 1 sl st in next st, cast off with long tail for sewing pieces together.

HEAD

1. In mc, MC of 6 or (Ch 2 and in 2nd ch from hook 6 sc) (6)
2. 2 sc in each st (12)
3. * 1 sc in st, 2 sc in st* repeat around (18)
- 4-5. * 1 sc in each st (18)
6. * 1 sc in st, c2tog* repeat around (12)
7. *c2tog* repeat around (6)
8. 1 sl st, cast off with tail for sewing pieces together.

BILL (Top)

1. ch 15
2. In 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in 4 st, c2tog (3 times), 1 sc in 4 st (11)
3. 1 sc in each st (11)
4. 1 sl st, cast off with long tail and weave down the middle to make the top bill.

BILL (Bottom)

1. ch 13
2. In 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in 4 st, c2tog (2 times), 1 sc in 4 st (10)
3. 1 sc in 3 st, c2tog (2 times), 1 sc in 3 st (8), cast off with long tail and weave down the middle to make the bottom bill.

ASSEMBLING

Stuff each piece with fiberfill, making each firm.
Sew Head to hole in top of Body section.
Attach Bill to front of the head.

FACIAL FEATURES

Glue eyes over row 3-6 above Bill or embroider eyes with black embroidery floss.



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
