Another Pixie Purrfect Pattern

Toboggan



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Toboggan



This is the pattern for a toboggan and is a remembrance of childhood. This toboggan can be hung as an ornament, stood up against a wall or laid flat as a decoration.

MATERIALS

Main Color: Worsted Weight Wool (Bernat Satin in Sable)

Contrasting Color: Worsted Weight Wool (Bernat Handicrafter Cotton in Natural)

Needle: Yarn needle for sewing.

Hook Size: 3.5mm (E/4) and 3.0mm (D/3) crochet hook.

Pipe cleaners for edges to make them firm and create the J shape.

Size: 1.5" tall and 7" long.

Gauge: Does not matter as bigger wool and bigger gauge will make larger toboggan.

NOTES:

Do not join rounds unless otherwise indicated.

Use a yarn marker or contrasting yarn to mark rows.

Keep crochet stitches close together so the stuffing will not show when brushed.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

st = stitch(es)

sl st = slip stitch

c2tog = crochet 2 st together

mc = main color

cc = contrasting color

MC = Magic Circle

TOBOGGAN

1. Ch 9
2. In second from hook 8 sc (8)
- 3-35. 1 sc in st (8)
36. 1 sl st in next st, cast off.

TOBOGGAN EDGES (All four edges)

Line the pipe cleaners up against the edges of the toboggan and sc over the pipe cleaner (so it hides the pipe cleaner)

CROSS BARS (make 7)

1. Ch 10, cast off with long tails for sewing. Sew five along the bottom of the toboggan, one across the front of the J, and one at the top of the curve at the end where connecting the chain.

ASSEMBLING

Use a few lengths of decorative chain to attach to top of the curve and connected to the bottom of the toboggan. If decorative chain is not available, use a strand of the same colored wool.

Attach a strand of the contrasting colored wool, as the rope used for steering.



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
